




SUMMER LEADERSHIP EXPERIENCE

The Amazon Future Engineer Scholarship recognizes individuals who have demonstrated exceptional academic performance exemplary leadership within their community, workplace, and school.

CHICKPEA NOODLE SOUP

What better way to transition into the fall season than with a hearty soup recipe! This simple recipe incorporates all of the food groups.

METHOD

- 1. Warm the olive oil in a large deep saucepan or soup pot over medium heat, let it warm for about 1 minute, add the onion, celery, carrots, and 1/4 teaspoon salt.
- 2. Cook, stirring often until the onions are turning translucent, and soften about 7 minutes.
- 3. Add the turmeric and curry powder if used, and stir constantly for about 30 seconds to wake up their flavors. Add the bay leaf, chickpeas, pasta, parsley, poultry seasoning, and broth.
- 4. Raise the heat to high and bring the mixture to a boil, then reduce heat to medium-high, and continue simmering until the pasta is pleasantly tender.
- 5. Remove the pot from the heat and season generously with pepper.
 Add more salt, to taste.
 Serve while hot, with some parsley and pepper on top, as garnish.

INGREDIENTS

- 2 tablespoons olive oil 1 medium yellow onion, chopped 1 cup sliced celery (about 2 stalks) 1 cup carrot sticks or 2 medium carrots peeled and cut into thin rounds or cubes 1/4 teaspoon salt, more to taste 1/2 teaspoon ground turmeric 1/2 teaspoon curry powder (optional) 1 bay leaf 1 can chickpeas, rinsed and drained 34 cup spiral pasta or penne or farfalle or elbow 1 teaspoon "poultry" seasoning Note: "poultry" seasoning is vegetarian. 8 cups vegetable broth Ground black pepper, to taste (about 1/4 tsp) **2 Tablespoons** of chopped parsley or
 - cilantro (optional for garnish and extra flavour)
